



In August 1974, Jean Pullin and Hazel Boyce became the City of Woodstock's first full-time bus drivers.

The former Capitol Theatre in Woodstock was many things to many people. It was built in 1864 as the Woodstock Opera House. In 1940, local business man Tom Naylor purchased the facility and over the years altered the footprint of the original interior due to strict building regulations, and ran it as a movie theatre. In the mid 1970s a second screen was added. The Capitol closed its doors for good in 1999 and was demolished in 2010.

I had been learning to drive with power steering, I turned the wheel to what I thought was enough and found myself in a different direction going the opposite way.


An invisible car came out of nowhere, struck my car and vanished.
